

Laura's Cowl



Materials:

100g 8ply wool (Approx.)

4.00 mm circular needles

Guage: 22st/10cm

Abbreviations: k - knit p - purl

m1 - make 1

s2kp - slip 1, knit 2 together, pass

slipped stitch over the knit 2 together

Caste on 120 stitches. (I have used a caste on method where you make your stitches BETWEEN the stitch. This gives a sturdy decorative edge.)

Knit the first row and then join into a continuous round of knitting, making sure you don't twist the stitches. (This makes that cast on row sit up.) Place a marker in your knitting at this join. Purl the next three rounds.

Pattern:

The pattern is worked over 10 stitches

Rounds 1,3,5,7 and 9: Knit

Round 2: *m1, k3, s2kp, k3, m1, k1: repeat from *

Round 4: *k1, m1, k2, s2kp, k2, m1, k2 ; repeat from *

Round 6: *k2, m1, k1, s2kp, k1, m1, k2: repeat from *

Round 8: *k3, m1,s2kp, m1, k4: repeat from *

Keep repeating the pattern until you reach the length desired. (I have used 6 repeats.)

To finish

Purl the next three rounds.

Turn the work to the WRONG side and knit the following round

Turn the work to the RIGHT side and cast off. To do this knit into the back of the stitch.
This will replicate the finish on the cast on end.
Sew in your ends and block your finished piece.
