



Purl & Plain Cowl

Materials:

100g 8ply wool
(Approx.)
4.00 mm circular needles

Abbreviations:-

k - knit p - purl

Guage: 22stk/10cm

Caste on 127 stitches.

(I have used a caste on method where you make your stitches BETWEEN the stitch. This gives a sturdy decorative edge.)

Knit the first row and then join into a continuous round of knitting, making sure you don't twist the stitches. (This makes that cast on row sit up.)

Place a marker in your knitting at this join.

Purl stitch the next round then Plain stitch the following round. Repeat these 2 rounds 4 more times.

(5 ridges)

Pattern:

The pattern is worked over 7 stitches. (K5, P2.)

Because the number of stitches is able to be divided by 7 + 1 (126+1) the pattern forms a spiral. Keep repeating the pattern until you reach the length desired.

(This was 5.5" in the piece illustrated)

To finish

Repeat the beginning border

Turn the work to the WRONG side and knit the following round

Turn the work to the RIGHT side and caste off. To do this knit into the back of the stitch.

This will replicate the finish on the cast on end.

Sew in your ends and block your finished piece.
