



Caro-Rose-Creations

PINWHEEL PIN HOLDER

Materials:

1. Recycled piece of embroidery
2. Fabric for reverse side
3. Soft, light weight wadding
4. Recycled cardboard (medium weight)
5. Tacky glue
6. Fine needle and polyester thread



Construction:

1. Use the 4" circles (included) to trace on your fabric for reverse side and embroidery.
2. Use the 3.5" template included to cut 2 x cardboard shapes from the recycled cardboard and 2 pieces of wadding.
3. Glue wadding to cardboard.
4. Using a fine needle and a length of poly-cotton thread I ran a line of small gathering stitching around the edge of the embroidery and the reverse side fabric, starting with a firm knot. (A small stitch gives a much more even gathering line.)
5. Inserted the mounding shape, pull up the gathering thread and secured the fabric in place.
6. Placing the inner sides of the circles together I stitched the two shapes together using a ladder stitch.
7. Decorate around the edge with pins.
