



**SUPER EASY 'PETITE SAC'**



**Materials (for sample petite sac)**

1 piece of fabric 12" x 14" (30cm X 35.5cm)  
1 nylon zipper 16" in length (40cm)  
Matching thread  
pins, tassel

*(if using a thin fabric add iron- on interfacing to the wrong side.)*



reverse  
stitch

**Method**

**step 1** Neaten the two shorter edges.

**step 2** Place zipper along short edge with overlap at each end and the WRONG side of the zipper facing up. Sew along the edge as shown in the illustration.

**step 3** Turn the fabric around and repeat at the opposite edge.

**step 4** Turn the fabric to the right side and iron in position.

**step 5** Turn the fabric to the wrong side and using the creases that were ironed, re-iron on the wrong side.

**step 6** Undo the zipper about half way and pin the ends in position.

**step 7** Sew down the side seams reversing at the beginning end and also when sewing across the zipper. Trim off zipper ends.

**step 8** Neaten side seams.

**step 9** Turn to the right side and iron. Add a tassel to the end of the zipper as a finishing touch.
